The fence was built from a local timber (eucalyptus), which is a common sight in the region, and was made of square posts and round rails.

POST AND RAIL

In the closely settled areas of Australia, which were mostly well farmed in the early days, the post and rail fence became the standard for fencing, for small holdings or lease, from 1790. It quickly became a symbolic image of rural Australia, eventually enclosing thousands of hectares of land.

The simplest post and rail fence consisted of pairs of closely spaced posts (about the same diameter as the rails), each pair spaced according to the length of the rails. The rails were dropped between the posts, alternating between panels. The posts were then tied at the top with green hide or wire to keep them spreading. The advantage of this form of fence was that it could be built with available local timber using rails from small diameter trees or from saplings.

Original and working, the first trap (earthen) was built by the Aboriginal people. It was made of earth and stones, with a narrow entrance.

THE FIRST FENCES

The first fences in Australia were built by Aboriginal people. The first to be recorded were those in Cygnet Harbour near Albany, Western Australia, by the navigator Captain George Vancouver in 1791. These were in the form of fish traps used to contain fish in estuaries and rivers so they could then be caught at leisure. Numerous traps were observed in the harbour and in the Kalgan River. Some were made of sticks stuck into the mud at close intervals, while others were made of stone or a combination of both. Fish either entered the trap at high tide and became trapped as the tide ebbed or were herded into it before the trap was closed. The fish were then either speared or caught by hand and thrown ashore.

FENCES OF AUSTRALIA

Jack Bradshaw

From stone to post and rail, from the utilitarian to the sculptural, a well-built fence is a thing of beauty and a monument to workmanship. These practical but symbolic structures are part of the story of Australia.

Starting with 7,000-year-old Aboriginal fish traps and ending with a look into the future in a chapter on virtual fencing, Jack Bradshaw traces the history of Australia's fences in words and pictures. *Fences of Australia* has 90 full-colour photographs from around the country. 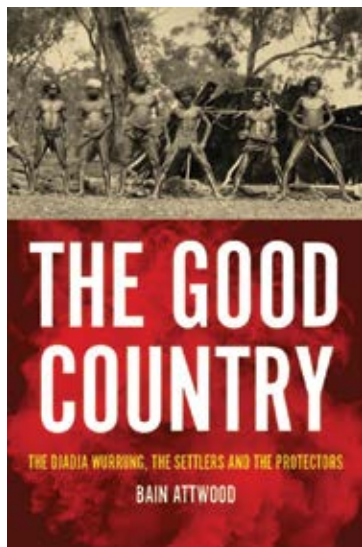

THE GOOD COUNTRY: THE DJADJA WURRUNG, THE SETTLERS AND THE PROTECTORS

Bain Attwood

Beyond the generalisations of national and colonial history, what can we know about how Aboriginal nations interacted with the British settlers who invaded their country, the men appointed by the imperial and colonial governments to protect them, and each other?

In *The Good Country* Bain Attwood makes a major contribution to our knowledge of this period by providing a superbly researched, finely grained local history of the Djadja Wurrung people of Central Victoria.

The story is a shocking one, of destruction, decimation and dispossession, but, equally powerfully, it is not one of unceasing conflict. With reference to an unusually rich historical record, concepts such as the frontier and resistance emerge as inadequate in this context. Attwood recovers a good deal of the *modus vivendi* that the Djadja Wurrung reached with sympathetic protectors, pastoralists and gold diggers, showing how they both adopted and adapted to these intruders to remain in their own country, at least for a time.

Finally, drawing past and present together, Attwood relates the remarkable story of the revival of the Djadja Wurrung in recent times as they have sought to become their own historians.

A LIFE FOR ANIMALS

A Life for Animals is the story of a life devoted to a radical idea: that animals should be treated with dignity and respect.

Christine Townend founded Animal Liberation Australia in 1976 after reading Peter Singer's book of the same name. Despite a largely indifferent and sometimes hostile public, she campaigned relentlessly to raise awareness of animal welfare in Australia.

In 1990, weary of Australian politics, she accepted an invitation to visit a small, run-down animal shelter in Rajasthan. There she encountered shocking human and animal suffering – but also the extraordinary power of human and animal interaction. As she edged her way into the life of the shelter, she found herself unexpectedly attached: to the animals, to her colleagues, and to India.

In *A Life for Animals* Christine Townend records the successes and challenges of animal welfare work, the critical moments that have shaped her philosophy, and the profound personal and political consequences of sharing a life with animals. Apart from being an animal rights activist, she is also a poet, novelist and artist, and an all-round fascinating human being.
